Tuition Payments

If you are on the tuition installment plan, payments are due the first of each month. The Academy does not charge late fees if payments are delinquent, so please reciprocate the courtesy by making your payments on time. The next monthly installment will be due on December 1st.

Students on the semester plan: your spring semester fees are due on or before January 15, 2010. All students are automatically enrolled for spring semester classes; you do not have to do anything extra. Note: If you need to withdrawal your dancer from classes, you must submit a withdrawal form before the first of the month to be relieved of additional tuition payments.
